The plaintiff, R.L.Black, states that on the 27th day of March, 1920, the defendant, W.R.Currens, executed and delivered for value received to him his certain premissory note for the sum of \$60.00 with interest thereon from said date until paid. He says that no part of said note or interest thereon has ever been paid though demand for payment has been repeatedly made. Said note is filed herewith and made a part hereof. He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just; that plaintiff ought to recover thereon said amount with interest thereon; that defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and the demands of the defendant's creditors and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$60.00 and interest thereon at the rate of 6% from the 27th day of March 1920 until paid and all the costs of this action and for a summons against Sandusky Bro's. & Co., as garnishee.
