The plaintiff, Cogar Grain and Coal Company says it is a corporation organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, with power to carry on a general Coal Feed and Grain Business, with power to sue and be sued.

The plaintiff Cogar Grain and Coal Company, says that, on and between the 12th. day of April 1923 and the 20th. day of May 1925, he sold and delivered to the defendant, W.L. Graham merchandise of the value or ~~\$215.40 with credits~~ The particulars of which are stated in the copy filed herewith, marked "A"

of the plaintiff's account of said sales. The defendant has paid of said account \$43.33 on October 13, 1923, \$25.00 March 20th. 1925 and \$4.50 May 20th. 1925/. On June 1st. 1925 the plaintiff requested the defendant to pay said account, but he has not paid any part thereof nor any interest thereon.

Wherefore the plaintiff asks for Judgement against the defendant for \$142.57 and interest thereon from June 1st. 1925, and costs and any other relief the plaintiff may appear entitled to.
