v. Statement.

Mrs. Lillie Norton, Defendant.

The plaintiff, Larkin Company, states that at the special instance and request of the defendant it sold and delivered to the defendant, Mrs. Lillie Norton, goods, wares and merchandise of the value of \$20.75 which received and accepted on the terms set forth in the printed account filed herewith and promised to pay for same within 30 days from April 12, 1921, and upon which account she paid the sum of \$3.00 on April 6, 1922, but no other or further sum, the remainder thereof being due and unpaid.

Wherefore the plaintiff prays judgment for \$20.75 with interest thereon at the rate of 6 per centum per annum from May 12, 1921, until paid, subject to a credit of \$3.00 as of April 6, 1922, for costs and all proper relief.
