The plaintiff Porter Lynch states that in Jany 1921 he purchased from the defendant F C Chelf 30 bushels of Soy beans at \$3.25 per bushel and paid him therefor in cash the said sum. That the defendant neglected, failed and refused, to ship to the plaintiff the said beans after the acceptance of said cash, and has neglected, failed and refused to repay to the plaintiff the amount so paid him for said seed, and that he is indebted to the plaintiff for said amount with interest thereon from the date of payment.

Wherefore he prays judgment against the defendant for the said sum of \$97.50 with interest thereon from Jany 1st 1921 and for his cost and for all proper relief.
