The plaintiff, Lawson & Son, say they are a partnership composed of the members Luther Lawson and W.A. Lawson; that they were at the time the account herein was contracted running a general store in Harrodsburg, Ky.; that in the year 1921, they sold and delivered to the defendant, Tom Lyons, at his special instance and request goods and merchandise to the value of \$80.00 for which the said Tom Lyons agreed and promised to pay therefor said amount of \$80.00.

He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just and unpaid; that he ought to recover thereon said amount. He says that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demands and the demands of the defendant's creditors and that the collection of the said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found.

Wherefore plaintiffs pray for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$80.00, for all costs of this action, for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant.

He prays for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled-- special, general and property.
