Harvey Bradshaw,

you cause to be made the sum of Fifteen Dollars,

(\$15.00) Dollars and Cents,
which the Commonwealth of Kentucky, assessed against them

late in our Mercer Quarterly Court hath recovered against them for debt, with interest
thereon at the rate of 6 per cent per annum from the 21st day of January-1931, 1931,
until paid; also the sum of Three Dollars and Fifty cents, which in said Court
was adjudged to the said Court

for its costs in that suit expended, whereof the said defendants was convicted,
as appears of record; and that you have the said sums of money before our said Court on the 24th
day of February-1931, 1931 to render to said Commonwealth

debt, interest and cost aforesaid, and have then and there this writ. -1931
