The Plaintiff states that on Feby 20, 1923 the defendant executed and delivered to J. M. Johnson Cash his check of that date drawn on First National Bank of Harrodsburg, Ky for \$118.85; that said check was duly presented for payment but payment thereof was refused and no part of said check has ever been paid; that it is filed herewith and made a part hereof.

The Plaintiff says that this is an action to recover the money due on said check and contract; that the amount thereof with interest is just due, owing and unpaid; that he believes he should have and recover the full amount of said check and interest; that the defendant has not sufficient property in this State subject to execution to pay and satisfy the amount due to the plaintiff on said check and the collection thereof will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found.

He states that the check is the property of plff W. R. McCray and has been endorsed to him but the original payee thereof is joined as a Plaintiff.

Wherefore the Plaintiff prays judgment for \$118.85 with 6% interest from Feby 20, 1923 and his costs; for a general order of attachment and for all proper relief.
