The plaintiff, Gabhart & Youman, state that they were prior to May 1924 partners engaged in the practice of medicine at Harrodsburg, Ky.; that during the period of their partnership they practiced in the family of defendant, J.W.Williams, at his special instance and request to the extent of \$192.00 no part of which has ever been paid and said Williams is now indebted to the said partnership in said amount.

Said firm is composed of W.S.Gabhart and R.E.Youmans, doctors of medicine as aforesaid.

Plaintiff says that defendant has sold and is about to sell and otherwise dispose of his property with the fraudulent intent to cheat hinder and delay this plaintiff in the collection of said debt and that said defendant is about to take and remove his property out of this State without leaving enough therein to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of the said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same and that defendant is now a non resident of this State and absent ~~his Post office address is unknown to affiant~~ herefrom. That said debt is past due, unpaid and payment has been frequently demanded but refused.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$192.00 and all the costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant and for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled.
