

believes it ought to recover thereon the said sum of \$36.55 with interest thereon from January 21st., 1922; that the defendant has no property in this state subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy and pay plaintiff's debt, interest and costs and the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and return of no property found.

Wherefore, plaintiff prays judgment against the defendant, Sam Scott, for the sum of \$36.55; for interest thereon from January 21st., 1922; for costs of the suit and prays for a general order of attachment of defendant's property or so much thereof as will satisfy plaintiff's demand and for all other relief to which it may appear to be entitled.
