payment of \$227.76 Feb. 18, 1919 with interest at 6% from Feb. 18, 1919,  
hereby grants, sell and mortgage unto the party of the second part the foll-

Six acres of tobacco on farm of Phil Royalty known as the Oliver  
Meredith place.

To have and to hold ~~xxxx~~ said property unto said party of second  
part, their successors and assigns forever provided nevertheless, that if  
the said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid on or before  
the 1st. day of Jan. 1922 the indebtedness aforesaid together with all  
interest and costs that may accrue thereon then this mortgage is null and  
void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
