

Warrant of Arrest.

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal, or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that
Robert Hutchinson

*Breach of the peace by abusing Raymond Preston and striking him
with a stick and rock and by throwing a club at him,*

in the County of Mercer, the 25 day of July, 1919.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said *Robert Hutchinson*
and bring *him* before me to be dealt with according to law.

Given under my hand as Judge of the Mercer County Court this 26 day
of July, 1919.

Summon *Raymond Preston, Reed Phillips, Robert Preston,*
as witness for plaintiff and

for Defendant.

The arresting officer may take bail in the sum of \$ 100.00 for the appearance
of defendant for trial on a day to be fixed by said officer in the bail bond according to law.
