The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal, or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that Robert Hutchinson

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Robert Hutchinson
and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.
