The plaintiff, Wm. Tatum, states that the defendant, Lee Tyler, is indebted to him in the sum of \$38.20 for money paid by him on a fine owed by defendant for violating the local option law.

Said Tyler promised to repay same to the plaintiff, but has not done so, although payment is long past due and has been repeatedly demanded. He says that this claim is just, and that defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy this debt and the defendant's creditors, and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found.

Wherefore he prays judgment against this defendant in the sum of \$38.20, for all costs of this action, and for a general order of attachment against the property of said defendant including a summon against George Chinn and the Chinn Mineral Company as garnishee.
