The plaintiff, Sam Campbell, states that the defendant, Will Curtsinger, is indebted to him in the sum of \$120.00 for goods and merchandise sold and delivered to him at his special instance and request. He says that defendant agreed and promised to pay therefor the contract price of \$120.00; that said debt is long past due and unpaid though payment has been repeatedly demanded.

He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just, due, and unpaid, and defendant ought to recover thereon said amount. He says that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demands and the demands of the defendant's creditors and that the collection of the said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same. Copy will be filed on request. Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$120.00 and for all the costs of this action and for all the relief to which he is entitled including a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant.
