

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

H. F. Harris

has committed the offense of

uttering a check on a bank or other depository ~~without~~ knowing  
at the time of uttering he had not sufficient funds insaid bank or  
depository to said check in full upon its presentation.  
in the County of Mercer, the 25 day of August 1930.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said H. F. Harris

and bring ~~me~~ him before me to be dealt with according to law.
