
Sunrise in the Virgin Islands

IMPROVING PASTURES IN KENTUCKY (Lexington Herald)

Many farmers have the idea that because they do not live in the Blue Grass Region of Central Kentucky they cannot produce good blue grass pastures. The Animal Husbandry and Agronomy Departments at the Kentucky Experiment Station have disproven this idea. At the West Kentucky substation a series of fields were used in a pasture test for producing beef. One field was not treated in any way—while one was treated with rock phosphate and the other with limestone and phosphate. The treated fields produced three times as much beef and at less cost. The cattle that grazed on the treated fields also sold higher at the market and returned a greater net profit than the others. This method of improving pastures offers good opportunities for farmers in all sections of the state.

Each lot was seeded with a mixture of a number of grasses and legumes. Korean lespedeza was one of the most productive crops produced. This good legume comes into its prime in mid-summer and lasts until fall. It is being widely sown now and within the next few years should be in even greater favor than at the present time. Korean has improved bluegrass pastures and more of it should be seeded in Kentucky.

Black Country in England

The Black country is the highly industrialized region mostly in Staffordshire and partly in Worcestershire and Warwickshire, England. The site of innumerable coal mines, furnaces, iron-works and laborers' dwellings, it is an unlovely and poverty-ridden region. It furnishes the background for a number of England's modern realistic novels.

Early Use of Garlic

Of all the numerous kinds of amulets, talismans and other objects that have been used throughout the ages to ward off evil spirits, the most sensible one was employed in the protection of Danish children many years ago. It was Garlic—eaten three times a day—solely for this purpose.—Collier's Weekly.


Ancient Maps




