We command you, that you have the body of Doris Freeman, detained in your custody, as it is said, together with the day and cause of her being taken, at the Courthouse of the County in which this writ is served, Before the Circuit Judge of said County, on Saturday July 23, at the hour of 5 P.M.; and that you then and there state in writing your authority for so doing; and ~~here~~^{before} hereof you are not to fail, under the penalties denounced by law against those who disobey this writ, and to submit to and receive all these things which shall then and there be adjudged in his behalf.
