

that they believe they should have and recover of the defendant \$5 \$45.00 and interest and costs; that the defendant has no agent in this State known to the Plaintiffs on whom summons can be lawfully served; that it is a non-resident and now absent therefrom; they state that they do not know the State in which the defendant is incorporated, nor the State or City or Post office address of any of the agents or officers of the defendant, or where any of them may be found; that they do not know the post office address of the defendant or the post office nearest to ~~km~~ its residence or the post office address of ~~any~~ its officers or agents, nor the nearest post office address to them or any of them.

Wherefore they pray warning order against the defendant with a general order of attachment and garnishment and that ~~suff~~ they recover judgment for \$45.00 interest and costs and that sufficient of the defendant's property be subjected to the payment thereof to satisfy said sum interest and costs.
