

PAR: 1. The plaintiff, J.L.Gritton, states that on the 21 day of

January, 1881, the defendant, D.M.Brown, executed and delivered to him

for value received his certain promissory note for the sum of \$125.00,

due and payable in 6 months from date with interest thereon from date un-

til paid; that on the 15th day of April, 1881, there was paid in said

note the sum of \$20.00; that on the 11th day of October, 1881, there was

paid on this note the sum of \$20.00. He says that no other sums have been

paid thereon and that the balance of said note is now past due and un-

paid though payment has been repeatedly demanded.

Wherefore, etc.

PAR: 2. The plaintiff without waiving any of the allegations of para-

graph No. 1, but reaffirming and reasserting them as fully as if set out

hereto and for other and further cause of action against the defendant

alleges that in the year 1881, he said and delivered to the defendant at

his special instance and request goods and merchandise to the value of

\$12.47; that said account is past due and unpaid. The said note and ac-

count are filed herewith and made a part hereof and marked "A" & "B" res-

pectively for identification. He says that this is an action for money

due upon a contract and that it is just and due and plaintiff ought to re-

cover thereon said amounts and interest thereon from date. He says that de-

fendant has no property in this State subject to execution, or not enough

thereof to satisfy the plaintiff's demands and the demands of the defend-

ant's creditors and that the collection of the said demand will be endan-

gered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in

the sum of the above amounts with interest thereon from date and for a gen-

eral order of attachment against the property of the defendant including a

summons against the Ohio Valley Fire & Marine Insurance Co. & The American

Alliance Insurance Company, of New York, He prays for all relief. 117-
