

Warrant of Arrest

**The Commonwealth of Kentucky,**

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

Nelson Yeast

has committed the offense of

executing and delivering to Louis Levith a check on First National Bank without funds in said bank to pay same

in the County of Mercer, the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 1920.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said

Nelson Yeast

and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.
