The Plaintiff states that the defendant is a corporation operating a line of railway through Mercer County, the right of way of which adjoins his lands; that the defendant has permitted and suffered the fencing along its right of way between his land and its right of way to fall down and become out of repair and insufficient to turn stock of any kind, so that by reason thereof his stock have from time to time passed out through the same and on to the defendant's right of way where they have been killed by the deft's trains, thus;-
