The Defendant, Tom Lyons, having been duly summoned herein and failing to answer, it is adjudged by the court that the Plaintiff, M.L. Ransdell, recover of said Defendant the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) and interest thereon at the rate of 6 per centum per annum from Feb. 10, 1922, until paid, and his cost herein expended. The court further adjudges that to secure the payment of said sum, interest and cost, the Plaintiff has a valid and subsisting lien on a FIVE PASSENGER FORD AUTOMOBILE, ENGINE NUMBER 1904953, now in possession of Defendant, and is entitled to a sale thereof to satisfy this judgment. Sw Kennedy, Sheriff of Mercer Co. is hereby appointed special commissioner to make said sale, and he is hereby authorized to take possession of said automobile for the purpose of sale. He ~~shall~~ have the same appraised before advertising the sale, and if the appraised value is \$100.00 or more, he will advertise ~~in~~ the time, terms and place of sale, and the sum for which it is to be made, together with a description of the property to be sold, by written or printed notices posted up; ONE at the court house door in Harrodsburg, Ky., and THREE others at public places in the vicinity of the residence of the Defendant, for at least 15 days next preceding the day of sale, and by publication in some newspaper published in Harrodsburg, Ky., at least once a week for THREE consecutive weeks immediately preceding the date of sale. If said appraisement be less than \$100.00, the commissioner is directed to leave off the newspaper advertisement. He is directed to make said sale at the courthouse door in Harrodsburg, Ky., on a day to be fixed by himself, at public outcry, to the highest and best bidder, on a credit of THREE MONTHS. He will take bond from the purchaser with good and approved surety for the purchase price.
