The plaintiff, M. Piowaty & Sons, state that it is a corporation created and organized under the laws of the State of _____, and is authorized to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with and to conduct generally the business of wholesale fruit and vegetable dealers and distributors, under and by its corporate name.

The plaintiff states that the defendant, Scott & Company, J. E. Scott, doing business under the firm name of Scott & Company, is indebted to it in the sum of \$50.25, for goods and merchandise sold and delivered to him in the months of May, June, and July, at said defendant's special instance and request. A statement of the account for which is filed herewith and made a part hereof, marked "A" for the purpose of identification. He states that said defendant promised to pay said sum which is reasonable, but that no part thereof has ever been paid, and that there is just and owing on said account the amount named above.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays a judgment against the defendant, J. T. Scott for the sum of \$50.25, with interest thereon from August 1, 1918, for its costs herein expended, and for all proper relief.
