The affiant, W. H. Raoyalty, states that he is one of the firm of Royalty Bros., composed of the affiant, W. H. Royalty and W. P. Royalty, doing business as a partnership, and engaged in a general merchandise business at Salvisa, Mercer County, Kentucky.

He states that the defendant, Dillard Brown, is indebted to the said partnership in the sum of \$17.32, for goods, wares and merchandise, sold and delivered to the said defendant in the year at said defendant's special instance and request; that an itemized statement of said account is filed herewith, and made a part hereof, marked "A" for the purpose of identification; that said account shows the items charged, and the amounts thereof, and states that the amounts charged therefor are reasonable. He states that the said claim is just, and that plaintiffs ought to recover the said sum of \$17.32, with interest thereon from November 1, 1921, at the rate of six per cent. That the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiffs' demand, and that the collection of the said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment or a return of no property found.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiffs, W. H. Royalty and W. P. Royalty, partners doing business under the firm name of Royalty Bros., pray judgment against the defendant, Dillard Brown, for the said sum of \$17.32, with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent. per annum from November 1, 1921, and for ~~his~~ their costs herein expended; that a general order of attachment be issued herein against all the property of the said defendant, including garnishees, and that enough of any property or money which may taken herein be subjected to the payment of said plaintiffs' debt, interest and costs. They pray for all proper relief.
