Plaintiffs state that the defendant Clate Anderson is indebted to them in the sum of \$6.00 with interest thereon at six per cent from February 1st., 1918 ; that this amount is due the plaintiffs from the defendant as drawer of a bank check whixh defendant signed and delivered to plaintiffs and by which defendant promised to pay plaintiffs the sum above stated, said check is filed herewith as part hereof.

Plaintiffs state that said check was drawn on the Mercer National Bank of Harrodsburg, Kentucky and that payment of same was demanded at said Bank at maturity but defendant had no funds at said Bank and the same was not paid , of which defendant has had due notice and demand has been made upon said defendant for payment but he has refused payment

Wherefore, Plaintiffs asks judgment against defendant in the sum of \$6.00 with interest thereon from February 1st., 1918 for their costs herein expended and for any other relief to which they may appear to be entitled.
