The Defendant, Thomas Scott, having been duly summoned, and failing to answer, it is adjudged that the Plaintiffs, Sandusky Bros., recover of said Defendant the sum of One Hundred and Fifteen & 50/100 Dollars (\$115.50), with interest thereon at the rate of 6 per centum per annum from April 2, 1921, until paid, and his cost herein expended.

It is further ordered herein that Plaintiffs' attachment be sustained.

Plaintiffs acknowledge receipt of \$56.25 and the cost of this action amounting to \$10.15, proceeds arising from sale of personalty under the attachment. It is, therefore, ordered that Plaintiffs' ~~cost~~ ^{Judgment} be credited by \$56.25, as of April 30, 1921.
