The Louisville Courier-Journal Agent's Agreement

This Agreement, Entered into the... 1 ... day of April 1920
between Ben Steele of Harrodsburg
Kentucky, and THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL COMPANY, of Louisville,
Ky., is with the understanding that in consideration of being appointed Agent of THE
LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL COMPANY, at Harrodsburg
the said Ben Steele agrees to the following conditions:

1-That previous to giving up the agency he will give THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL CO. at least thirty days' notice in writing, of such intention.

2-That the list of subscribers to THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL, shall be the sole property of THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL CO., and that he will not sell this list or turn over the agency to any other party, without the written consent of THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL CO. And that, furthermore, he will turn over to THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL CO., or its authorized representative, upon demand, a correct and full list of THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL subscribers in his town.

3-That while acting as Agent for THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL CO., he will do all he can to build up the circulation of THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL, delivering the same at the established rates: Daily, 10 cents a week; 45 cents a month; single copies two cents, Sunday, seven cents.

4-That for a violation of any one of the three provisions the agent shall pay to THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL CO., the sum mentioned in the bond hereto attached, which is agreed upon as liquidated damages and not in any way in the nature of a penalty.

5-That he will pay by the 10th day of each month for all papers sent him during the preceding month, at the rate of \$1.00 per one hundred copies for the daily edition and \$4.50 per one hundred copies of the Sunday edition.

6-That THE LOUISVILLE COURIER-JOURNAL COMPANY shall have the right to deprive him of the agency at any time should he fail to comply with the above conditions.
