The plaintiff Dessie Edwards states that she conducts a general Merchandise store at Salvisa, Kentucky, under the name of The Underselling Store, and that the defendant Cogar Cunningham is indebted to her for goods, wares and merchandise which she furnished and delivered to him and for which he agreed to pay, in the sum of \$9,80. She says that said claim is just, due and unpaid and she believes that she ought to recover the said amount from the defendant with interest and costs.

Wherefore she prays judgment against the defendant Cogar Cunningham for the sum of \$9,80, with interest from the 1st day of January, 1929, for her costs herein and for all other relief to which she may appear entitled.
