

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky, *Anderson Co*

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

H. F. Sutton,

500 has committed the offense of

Uttering a check on the Anderson National Bank of
Anderson County, Kentucky, and no Funds to meet same,

in the County of Mercer, the 11th day of JULY 1930.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said H. F. Sutton,

and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.
