TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Plaintiff, Anderson National Bank of Lawrenceburg, Kentucky states that it is a corporation with the authority to carry on the business of banking and having its place of business in Lawrenceburg, Anderson county, Kentucky; that the defendant, T. B. Gorham by a writing dated the 15th., day of August 1921, which he signed and executed and delivered to plaintiff, and which is filed herewith as part hereof, marked "Exhibit A" promised to pay to plaintiff eighty dollars (\$80.00) six months after said date, to wit on the 15th., day of February 1922, with interest from August 15th., 1921 until paid, at the rate of six percent per annum.

Plaintiff says that defendant has not paid said \$80.00 or any part thereof, or any interest thereon and that same is now due and owing this plaintiff and is wholly unpaid.

Wherefore, Plaintiff, Anderson National Bank asks judgment against defendant for the said sum of \$80.00 with interest thereon from 15th day of August 1921, at six percent per annum; for reasonable attorney's fees; for his costs herein expended and for all other proper relief.
