TO THE SHERIFF OR ANY CONSTABLE OF MERCER COUNTY:

Whereas S. L. Bailey hath made  
complaint to me as Judge of the Mercer County Court, that  
Calvin Travis  
did on the 27th., day of March, 1914, forcibly  
detain from the said S.L.Bailey one house and yard situated on the farm of  
the said S.L.Bailey in Mercer County, Ky., on the Harrodsburg and Lexington  
turnpike and adjoining the land of Heward Forsythe

which the said Calvin Travis, tenant  
of the said S.L.Bailey now holds against him

You are therefore commanded to summon the said Travis  
to appear at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky., to answer on the  
1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1904, the charge of  
forcible Detainer aforesaid, and give to the said  
Travis at least three days'  
notice of the time and place of the trial, and have then and there this writ.
