To The Sheriff of Mercer County,

Whereas B. W. Allin and M. M. Daviess have made complaint to me that B. M. Bonta did on the day of January 1914 forcibly detain from them a store house and lot in the City of Harrodsburg, Mercer County, Ky on the East Side of Main street, bounded on the North by building now occupied by Board Bros as soft drink stand, on the East by Greenville St, and B. Birdwhistel on the South by building occupied by J.M.Bixler/as furniture and dry goods store, and on the West by Main Street, which said building was in the possession of B. M. Bonta and which said B. M. Bonta, their tenant now holds against them; you are therefore commanded to summon B. M. Bonta to appear before me at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky, on Monday Feby 2, 1914 ^{at 10am} at which time inquiry will be made and a trial had as to said forcible detainer and you will give the defendant three days notice of said hearing.
