At appearing that the defendant plaintiff has an attachment upon a Ford ~~early~~ five passenger touring car, levied upon and now in the possession of the Sheriff, and the attachment thereon having been sustained, it is now ordered that the S W Kennedy Sheriff of Mercer County sell said car before the Court House door in Harrodsburg Ky on some day fixed by himself on a credit of Three months, and will take bond from the puchaser with approved security payable to himself for the purchase price, Before making said sale he will advertise the time, and the place therefor, together with the amount for which said property is to be sold, and it appearing from an appraisement that the said property is worth less than \$100. said advertisement will be by written or printed notices posted up, one at the Court House door and three others in conspicuous places in Harrodsburg Ky.

On the sale of said property and the collection of the purchase money therefor, he will pay to the plaintiff the amount of ~~interest from March 4, 1921, and \$3.57 each~~ its debt, to wit \$57.38<sup>1</sup> and the cost of this action, and the surplus if any he will pay to the defendant.
