That on Oct 4, 1922, the defendant J. D. Mulligan, by gross carelessness and negligence in the operation and running an automobile on a public highway in Mercer County Ky ran the same over and against the horses the property of the plaintiffs and of the value of \$100 - killing them to plaintiffs damage in said sum of \$100 -
