

The plaintiff states that the nature of the claim is as above set out; that they are just, due and owing and that the plaintiff ought to recover of the defendant the sum of \$44.00 with 6% interest from March 19th, 1913 and sum of \$17.40 with interest from January 1st, 1914. It states that this is an action for the recovery of money against the defendant and that he is about to sell, convey and otherwise dispose of his property with the intent to cheat, hinder and delay his creditors, including this plaintiff.

Wherefore, the plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$44.00 with interest from March 19th, 1913 until paid and the further sum of \$17.40 with interest from January 1st, 1914 until paid and for general order of attachment against the property of the defendant herein. It prays for its cost and all proper relief.
