Comes Garnishee and states that James A. Meaux, whose address is McAfee, Kentucky, delivered to it on January 4th, 1923, 1875 pounds of tobacco of the 1922 crop, for which was issued participation certificate #50874, on which was advanced the sum of \$144.43 to Jas. A. Meaux, and the further sum of \$82.00 was advanced to Mary & Sue Dunn, to apply on landlord's lien.

On May 26th, 1923, Garnishee paid the distribution accruing under said certificate to Jas. A. Meaux, in the sum of \$181.14.


On June 22nd, 1923, said certificate was assigned to Mercer National Bank, Harrodsburg, Ky., for "ALL".

On May 20th, 1924, Garnishee paid the distribution accruing under said certificate to Mercer National Bank, in the sum of \$53.09.

On February 15th, 1925, Garnishee paid the final distribution accruing under said certificate to Mercer National Bank, in the sum of \$93.83.

Garnishee is not informed that the James A. Meaux, whose account is listed herein, and the Ansel Meaux, defendant herein, are one and the same person, but if such is not the case, it prays to be allowed to amend its answer accordingly.

WHEREFORE, Garnishee prays to be protected in its rights, for its costs herein expended and for all proper relief.
