The plaintiff, Ed Vandyke, says that about one year ago, he signed a replevin bond for the defendant, Ansel Meaux, for One Hundred(\$100.00) and interest and costs all of which amounted to the sum of \$117.79 and all of which the defendant refused to pay and which plaintiff did pay and the copy of said bond will be filed if requested.

He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that defendant has no property in this State or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$117.79 and all the costs of this action and for all relief to which he is entitled including a general order of attachment against his property and for a summons against the Burkey Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association and for all other relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled-- special, general and proper-
