This case coming on to be heard and the defendant being in open Court and both sides announcing ready for trial, hold that a Jury come and came Frank Carey, Phil Beazley, W.N. Stagna, R.N. Gash, Joe Worley and Green Worley, who were impannelled and sworn according to law. After hearing the evidence, the said Jury retired to consult as to their verdict and presently returned unto Court the following verdict to-wit:-

"We the Jury find the defendant guilty and adjudge that he pay Ida Camic the sum of \$100. per year for 15 years. R.N. Gash, Foreman."

It is therefore ordered and adjudged that the defendant, Carl Edwards, is guilty as charged in the warrant and that the plaintiff, Ida Camic, recover of the defendant, Carl Edwards, the sum of \$100.00 per annum for a period of 15 years, making the total sum of \$1500.

It is therefore ordered and adjudged that said sum be paid at the end of each month, that is, the sum of \$8.33 be paid on the last day of February, 1916 and the same amount on the last day of each and every month thereafter for 15 years and said sums to bear interest from said date. It is further adjudged that to secure the payment of said amount, that the defendant execute bond, guaranteeing the faithful performance of this judgment. Thereupon the deft. declined to execute bond and it is ordered and adjudged that the Jailor of the Mercer County take charge of said defendant.
