

Warrant of Arrest.

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal, or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing <sup>from the oath of Miss Katie Carpenter</sup> that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

J. I. Messiman has committed the offense of  
not having his children between the  
ages of 7 and 14 years inclusive enrolled in  
or to attend any public school or private or parochi-  
al school and that said child is not being taught at  
home, as may be under the law after notice

in the County of Mercer, the October day of 1919.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said J. I. Messiman  
and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.
