

# BAIL BOND.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

The Defendant, R. J. Merrimon, being in custody of the Sheriff of Mercer County charged with the offense of failing to send his children to School and being admitted to bail in the sum of Forty Dollars

THEREFORE, we, R. J. Merrimon Principal and J. G. Polk Surety, of Mercer County, Kentucky do hereby undertake that the above named R. J. Merrimon shall appear in the Mercer County Court, on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1919, to answer to said charge, and shall at all times render himself amenable to the order and process of said Court in the prosecution of said charge, and if convicted shall render himself in execution thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions that we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of 50.00 Dollars.
