UPON PETITION.

The Petitioner, Zeletta G. Curry, Executrix of the will of George A. Curry, states that she was on the 6th day of June 1924 duly appointed and qualified in this Court as Executrix of the will of George A. Curry; that she on that date duly qualified as such, executing the bond and taking the oath required by law and is now acting in that capacity.

She states that there came into her hands as Executrix of said will the following Liberty Loan Bonds:-
