The Plaintiff, W.H. Graham, states that the defendant, Homer Yates, by a writing dated February 21st., 1916 which he executed and delivered to this plaintiff and which is filed herewith as part hereof, promised and agreed to pay to plaintiff the sum of \$35.00 with interest from date until paid.

Plaintiff says that said note is subject to a credit of \$        leaving a balance due of \$13.40 with interest thereon from March 1919. Plaintiff says that said note is just due and unpaid and the demand has been made defendant has failed and refused to pay said balance or any part of the same.

Wherefore Etc.

Plaintiff says that this is an action for money due upon a contract ; that said claim is just ; that it believes it ought to recover thereon the said sum of \$13.40 with interest from March 1919 ; that the defendant has no property in this state subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and return of no property found .
