The affiant, M. F. Hansford, states that the defendants, Ben and Will Watts are indebted to him in the sum of \$49.50, subject to a credit of \$10.00 for goods and merchandise bought by the defendants from this plaintiff and for which they agreed to pay the sum set out above.
