The plaintiff, V.L.Hendren, states that in the month of April 1919, the defendant executed and delivered to him for value received his certain promissory note for the sum of \$50.00 with interest thereon at the rate of 6% from date until paid and no payment has ever been made thereof. He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just, due, and unpaid though payment has been repeatedly demanded. He says that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that demands of the defendant's creditors and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found. Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$50.00 and interest thereon from April---, 1921, until paid and all costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant including a summon against the Burley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association as garnishee. He prays for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled.
