In The Matter Of Lottie S. Renfro, Oil Inspector-

The affiant, Lottie S. Renfro, states that she was appointed oil inspector of Mercer County, Ky. on the 14th day of September, 1921, to fill out an unexpired term in said office which term expires on the 14th day of September, 1924- She says that she has discharged faithfully and efficiently all the duties of the said office; that at no time has she been guilty of misconduct, negligence or of incompetency in the discharge of said duties- She says that she has inspected promptly every shipment of oil into the county for sale and use and consumption in said County; that no complaint on the part of any consumer of said oils except by competing oil companies or of the inspection thereof has ever to her knowledge been made against her; that no oil has been shipped from Mercer County in barrels or casks or tanks which required inspection by her; that if any oil has ever been shipped into the county in barrels, casks, or tanks other than ear lots, which she has always inspected, she has never been notified of such shipment; that no report is required by law of the inspection of such oils; she says that she has never had any barrels, or casks, or other small receptacles to inspect or brand. She says that no barrels, casks, or tanks have been inspected by her which require to be branded 'Approved Tests' as all the oil so far as she has been notified and has knowledge of has been shipped into the county in ear lots and in ear tanks and pumped into the respective reservoirs of the companys handling oil-
