The defendant having been duly summoned and failing to answer it is adjudged that the plaintiff recover of him the sum of \$135.51, with interest thereon from date until paid, together with his costs herein expended.

It is further adjudged that to the extent of \$27.80, included in said sum, together with ~~xx~~ his costs, the plaintiff has a lien on one 1922 model/Buick roadster, motor No. 788571, 1928 license Mercer 11-75 and that he is entitled to have the same sold to pay that portion of said judgment.

The Sheriff of Mercer County will sell said automobile at some time to be fixed by him on a credit of three months; he will first have the machine appraised as is required for sales of similar property under execution and he will cause it to be advertised by posting a notice containing the time, terms and place of sale with a description of the property to be sold and the amount to be raised one at the place of sale and three at other places in the vicinity of the property to be sold for not less than ten days next preceding the date of sale; if the property is appraised for \$100.00 or more he will in addition cause said advertisement to be published once each week for three consecutive weekly issues of some newspaper published at Harrodsburg, Ky immediately preceding the date of sale. For the purchase money the purchaser will be required to give bond with good security and with interest from date of sale. The Sheriff will report his acts hereunder to this Court.
