This cause coming on to be heard on charges preferred against the Defendant for misconduct, negligence and incompetency in the discharge of her duties under the law as inspector of oils and fluids, the product of coal, petroleum and other bituminous substances, which may or can be used for illuminating purposes, manufactured in this state or brought into it before the same is consumed, used or sold to merchants or consumers within this state, evidence and argument of counsel being heard, the court is of opinion that the charges as to negligence of the Defendant in the discharge of her duties as such inspector are sustained by the proof. It is, therefore, as oil inspector of Mercer County is guilty of negligence in the discharge of her duties & adjudged that the Defendant Lotta Renfro, be, and she is, hereby removed from the office of oil and fluid inspector for Mercer County, and said office is now declared vacant. to all of which the Defendant objects & excepts
