In The Matter of Lottie S. Renfro, Oil Inspector-

Amended Response-

Comes now the respondent, Lottie S. Renfro, and with leave of Court <sup>permitted</sup> amends her response herein by alleging that she has never/samples to be taken from barrels, tanks, or other receptacles out of her presence either in person or by assistant or deputy, and has never received such samples as if they had been taken by her in person; she says that she has not continuously, or at all, accepted samples of oil and gasoline furnished by the owners of gasoline stations other than the owners of the stations for which the affiants, ~~W.B.~~ W.B. Morris & Lawrence Walker, are the legal agents and representative, and then only after the said agents and representatives aforesaid unloaded the oil without notifying her and that the said samples so furnished by said parties aforesaid was the only means by which she under the circumstances could inspect said oil at all. She says that she has not accepted any samples without at the time inspecting same and keeping a full report and record of same and that said report was furnished in person by her to said parties and also furnished to them as a public and official record; that she has not failed to brand any barrels or other containers as no barrels or other containers have ever been received for inspection except in tank cars which she has always inspected promptly upon receipt of notice that same has been received for inspection- That she has not permitted the owners of gasoline and oils to brand the containers as they pleased or to brand same at all with her knowledge or consent, and that she has not accepted their statements as to tests made by them and that they have not with her knowledge or consent made any test or branded any containers
