The plaintiff, Ft Harrod Motor Company, states that
it is a partnership composed of Walter Martin and G L Johnson.

That on August 1925 and at divers times thereafter, up

to and including June 1926, it sold and delivered to the defendant

divers repairs for a motor truck which was also sold and delivered

to the defendant; an itemized account of the said sales and articles

furnished is filed herewith as a part hereof; that the defendant made

divers payments on said truck but that there is a balance due thereon

as shown by said account of \$50.95 no part of which has ever been

paid.

They say that the defendant has not sufficient property

in this state subject to execution to satisfy the plaintiff's demand,

and that their demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judg

ment and a return of no property found; that the defendant has fraudu

lently sold, conveyed and otherwise disposed of his property, with the

fraudulent intent to cheat, hinder and delay the plaintiff in the collec

tion of its demand; that the plaintiff's claim is just and that they

ought to recover the sum of \$50.95.

Wherefore they pray judgment for the said sum, and their

cost, and for a general order of attachment against the defendant. They

pray for all relief to which they may be entitled.
