The plaintiff, C.R.French, says that on the -22-  
March  
day of April 1923, the defendant, Dal Robinson, executed and delivered to him his certain promissory note for the sum of \$25.00 with 6% interest thereon from date and due and payable in 6 months from date; he says that some time in the year 1926 he lost said note and that at said time no payment had ever been made thereon, and that defendant is indebted to him in said amount with interest as aforesaid. He says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; therefore; that it is just, due and unpaid and that defendant has no property in this State subject to execution to pay same and that the collection of a judgment of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same.

Wherefore, plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$25.00 with interest from the 22nd day of March 1923 until paid and all the costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of defendant and for all relief-
